Doximity Dialer Verification

To gain access to Doximity Dialer, two points of verification are required:

- 1 Healthcare Professional Verification**
 - Provide a professional/work email address
- 2 Identification Verification**
 - Scan a government issued ID or answer background verification questions

Verification is typically done when a healthcare professional registers their account. The process of account verification may vary by user depending on the steps completed at the point of registration.

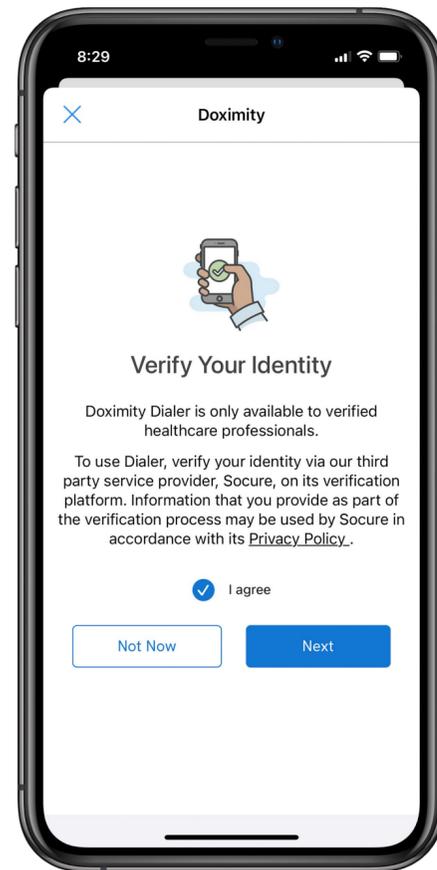
Healthcare Professional Verification

Healthcare professional verification requires a professional email address be associated with your Doximity account.

Add a hospital/health system or provider group email to your account and click the verification email to confirm ownership.

(Common domains including gmail, yahoo, AOL will not be verified.)

*Users view of verification may vary depending on verifications steps taken at the set-up point.



Identity Verification

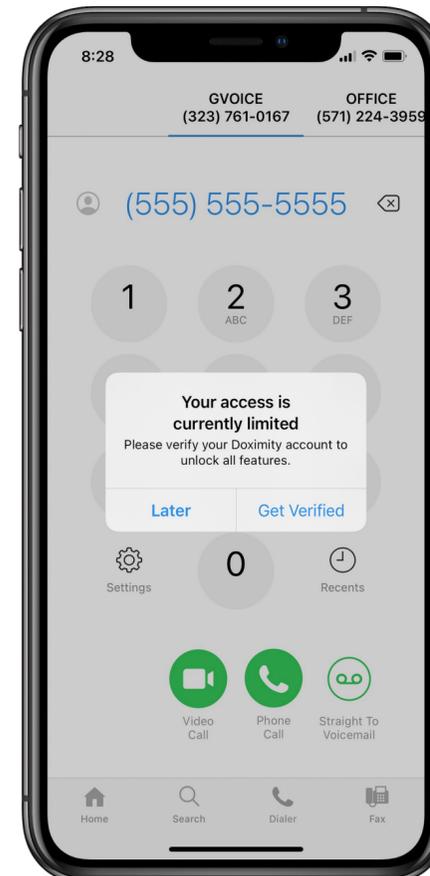
Identity verification can be set up at the point of registration or by clicking Dialer and following the prompts.

Identity verification can be obtained in one of two ways:

- Following the background check verification questions process during registration.

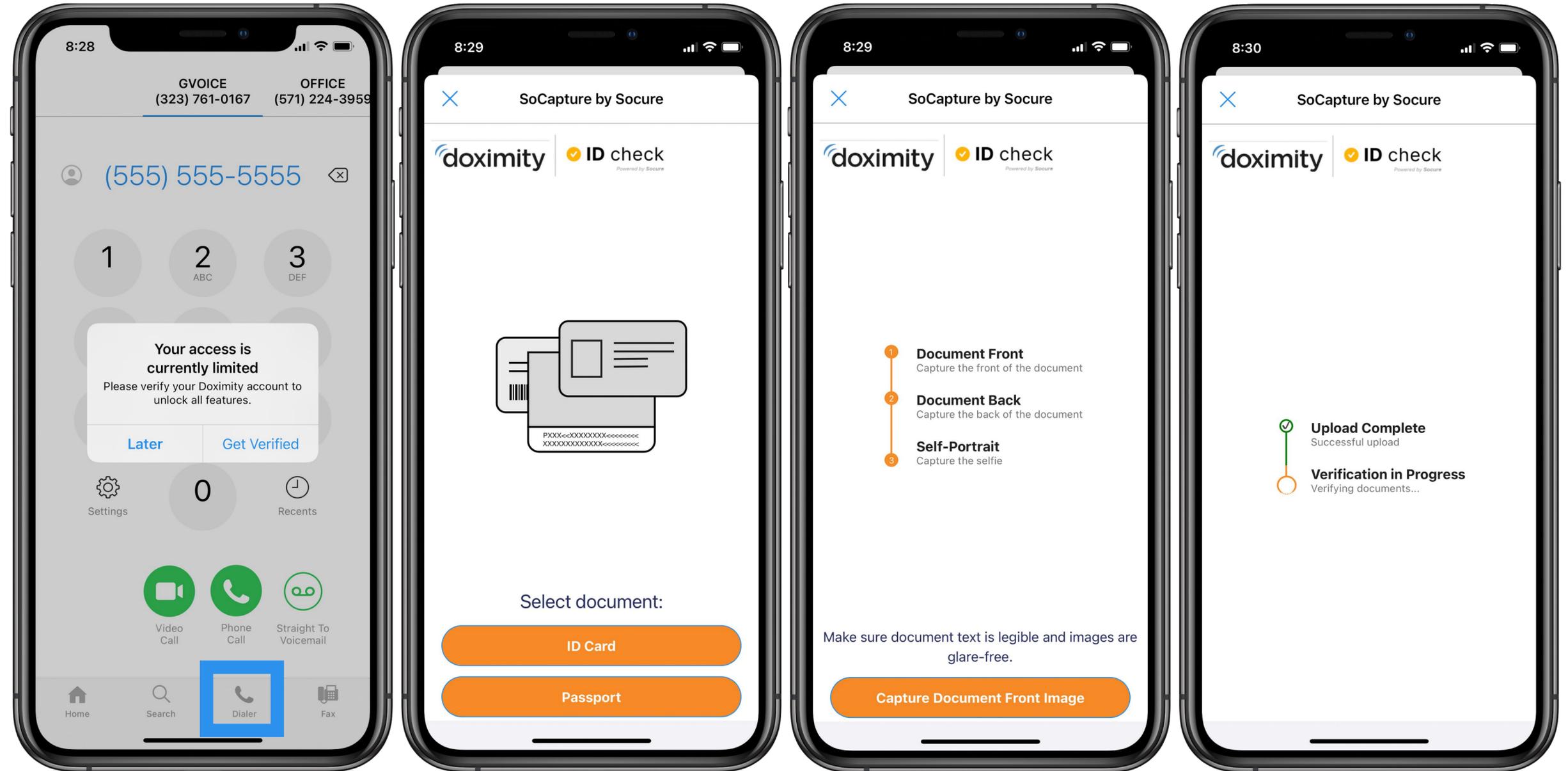
Or

- Scan a government issued ID and match it with a personal headshot photo.



Identification Verification

- 1 Start a call
- 2 Agree to terms and click next
- 3 Tap Photo ID
- 4 Scan ID with Socure (front and back)
- 5 Follow self-portrait instructions



Identification Verification

After the identification scans are complete, Follow the prompts to:

- 6 Submit your professional email address
- 7 Confirm your Doximity account through your professional/work email address

Desktop Verification

- 1 Go-to: doximity.com/get_verified
- 2 Click Photograph ID
- 3 Enter your mobile number
- 4 Complete the ID scan over your mobile phone
