DOXIMITY WORKPLACE NAVIGATOR TOP HOMETOWN HOSPITALS FOR DOCTORS METHODOLOGY

Data

Doximity's Top Hometown Hospitals for Doctors state ranking is based on reviews data submitted by eligible survey takers. Eligible survey takers 1) are verified Doximity members, 2) have MD or DO credentials, and 3) currently work at the reviewed hospital or have worked at the reviewed hospital within the last 10 years. The survey asks participants to provide a rating from 1-5 on the following dimensions: overall satisfaction, hospital culture, schedule flexibility, and support staff.

Physicians must be verified and logged into their Doximity accounts to access the survey: https://www.doximity.com/surveys/workplace_reviews

Methodology

The Top Hometown Hospitals for Doctors award recognizes outstanding hospitals for physicians to work that serve rural and less-densely populated urban communities across the U.S. To qualify, hospitals must have 500 or fewer beds and be located in counties with population densities of fewer than 500 people per square mile. Additionally, hospitals need to have at least 3 review to qualify. Hospitals that have already received other Doximity hospital workplace awards, such as the Top Hospitals for Doctors State award, are not eligible.

Winning hospitals are ranked within their respective regions. Reviews submitted from the last ten years are pooled to determine rankings, which are calculated by a combination of factors such as:

- Average ratings across overall satisfaction with the work experience, culture, schedule flexibility, and support staff
- Total number of verified reviews
- Recency of ratings and reviews

Out of 1.2k eligible hospitals, 111 received the 2023 Top Hometown Hospitals for Doctors award. Winners and rankings are updated at least annually.
